 - a. Research diary entries will be submitted to VERBI Software at the beginning, middle, and end of the research process and can cover any topic related to the research project and the (planned) use of MAXQDA. The first fieldwork diary entry is to be submitted no later than October 31st, 2018.
 - b. Each research diary entry will be accompanied by a minimum of 5 quality pictures for illustration (MAXQDA screenshots welcome) and need to have full permission/rights for VERBI Software to publish these materials on any platform.

Please note: VERBI Software GmbH may thus use the grant recipient's name, description of the research project, and submitted photos on VERBI's online and offline marketing material.
